What is the Euromed Cities Network?

The Euromed Cities Network, directly resulting from a Euro-Mediterranean partnership that places the Mediterranean at the centre of its reflections, has its origins in the Barcelona Process (1995). Today, it is a place of exchange, initiating a concrete and interactive dialogue in order to network the cities of the Mediterranean and Europe, with a view to long-term collaborations that are both emerging and strengthened. The permanent General Secretariat is based in Nice and intends to encourage the participation of all in the activity and life of the Network, whose Presidency is held by the Nice Cote d'Azur Metropolis.

What is BeMed?

The mission of the Monegasque association Beyond Plastic Med is to reduce plastic pollution at the root, by supporting and networking committed actors, implementing effective sustainable solutions and thus encouraging the search for new alternatives. In this perspective, BeMed launch each year, calls for innovative micro-initiatives in order to provide financing solutions to committed actors with promising projects.

A partnership between the Nice Cote d'Azur Metropolis and BeMed
